Alan and Vivian Trethewey Youth Philanthropist Award Guidelines

Introduction

This award recognizes service by a young person or group of young people ages 12 to 23 who have demonstrated outstanding commitment to helping others through fundraising efforts and/or volunteering.

Award Criteria

- Funds raised and/or amount of volunteer time
- Leadership demonstrated
- If part of a group, ability to work as a team player

Additional Material:

Provide a letter of reference from the organization or individual or family that benefitted from the funds raised by the nominee or benefitted from the nominee's volunteer efforts, <u>if possible</u>.

The Award

The recipient will receive a certificate of the award and \$500 will be donated to the recipient's charity of choice.

Judging

The Community Grants Committee of the Abbotsford Community Foundation will select the recipient of the Alan and Vivian Trethewey Youth Philanthropist Award. Selection will be based on the information contained in the Nomination Form. The committee may verify the information or seek out additional information if necessary. The successful nominee will be informed of the judging results no later than **Monday, November 2, 2020.**

Responsibilities

The selected winner must be able to attend the National Philanthropy Day Luncheon on **November 16**, **2020 at Evered Hall on the UFV campus** as the guests of the Abbotsford Community Foundation and will be advised ahead of time if they are the winner.

The runner up must also be available to attend the National Philanthropy Day Luncheon as the guests of the Abbotsford Community Foundation.

The Alan and Vivian Trethewey Youth Philanthropist Award Nomination Form, consent & waiver form and letter of reference must be submitted online no later than **Monday**, **October 5**, **2020**.
